Directions to Corn Rigg Cottage/Rusby Barn

- Come off at Junction 40 of the M6 motorway, and:
 - ➤ If travelling from the South, keep in the right hand lane and take the 4th exit of the roundabout for the A66 (signposted Scotch Corner, Brough, North Pennines Eden Valley).
 - ➤ If travelling from the North, take the 2nd exit of the roundabout for the A66 (signposted Scotch Corner, Brough, North Pennines Eden Valley).
- At the next roundabout, stay in the left hand lane and take the 2nd exit for the A686 (signposted Alston, Police H.Q, North Pennines and South Tynedale Railway).
- Stay on the A686 for approx. 6 miles (you'll go across a large bridge across the River Eden and follow the road round to go through Langwathby, then past the Carlisle-Settle railway station on your right and under the railway bridge).
- Keep following the A686, and signs to Melmerby and Alston, until you see a white signpost on the left for Ousby. Go right here (Hunters Cottage, a large black and cream house is on the right/corner).
- Keep on this road for approx. 2 miles until you reach the centre of Ousby and until you reach The Fox Inn pub on your left.
- Take the first left straight after The Fox Inn and follow the winding country lane (eventually passing Ousby Chapel on your left) until reaching a small T-junction where there is a house with a white gate (Row Head Farm) straight in front of you. Turn right here and follow the lane down for a few seconds until you reach Corn Rigg Cottage/Rusby Barn (on the right).
